



Net Zero Carbon Events announces collaboration with Gulf Organisation for Research and Development (GORD) at COP29

NZCE methodology will be integrated into the UN's reference tool for the measurement of events emissions, the Green Events Tool (GET)

Following the release of the Industry Roadmap at COP27 in Sharm El Sheikh and the launch of the Measurement Methodology in December 2023, Net Zero Carbon Events (NZCE) confirmed its latest development at this year's COP29 in Baku, Azerbaijan: the integration of NZCE methodology into the UN's reference tool for the measurement of events emissions, the Green Events Tool (GET).

This tool, developed by the United Nations and managed by the Gulf Organisation for Research and Development (GORD), is already instrumental in measuring the carbon footprint of UN conferences. Integrating the measurement methodology developed by NZCE for the business events industry will enhance GET's capabilities and align them with the industry's specific needs.

James Rees, President of the Joint Meetings Industry Council which hosts the Net Zero Carbon Events initiative for the conference, events and exhibitions industries worldwide said: "This is a very exciting development for Net Zero Carbon Events and for the industry. It takes our cooperation and integration with the United Nations' standards on measurement a significant step forward.

"The joint Launch Event at COP29 and the signing of an MoU between both institutions marks a commitment to substantive discussions, paving a pathway to future collaboration.

"Since its inception at COP26 in Glasgow, the Net Zero Carbon Events initiative has made remarkable progress in advancing sustainability practices within the business events industry. Thanks to the collective efforts of our community, we have achieved significant clarity on

environmental aspects relevant to our sector, clearing the way towards a more sustainable future."
